Influential Doctors of the Church


Monday, Nov 3, 10 & 17 at 7 p.m.

Chicken breasts stuffed with jalapeno and cream cheese




1/4 cup chopped pickled jalapeno
6 ounces of room temperature cream cheese
2 skin-on, bone-in split chicken breasts

Mix jalapenos into cream cheese. Spread mixture evenly underneath chicken skin; season with salt and pepper. Bake on parchment-lined baking sheet at 400 degrees until cooked through, 30 to 35 minutes; crisp skin under broiler.
