Children's Liturgy of the Word

Our Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) will be starting in November at our 10:30 am Mass. CLOW is for children ages 4 through grade 4. All children in this age group are welcome to come up toward the altar at the beginning of the Mass when the priest calls for the children. We have trained volunteers to lead these children through the Liturgy of the Word at an age appropriate level. The children will hear the Sunday readings proclaimed and a brief reflection on those readings by the adult leader. Children will return to the large congregation around the time of the collection.

Our hope is to offer this great ministry weekly year round. This will not only help our children explore the scriptures at their level, but offer parents an opportunity to focus more on listening to the readings proclaimed.

In the past, our parish has offered a pre-school program during the 10:30 am Mass. Unfortunately, we are not able to offer it at this time. A team is being gathered to look at how we could best serve our families with young children moving forward. Please keep this team and planning process in prayer. More details will be forthcoming.

Baked Fish

1 lb. fish (Northern, cod, Pollock or similar kind)

1/4 c. melted butter

2 tsp. soy sauce

2 tsp. lemon juice

1 tsp. lime juice

1/4 tsp. salt

1/8 tsp. pepper

1 clove garlic, minced

1/4 tsp. crushed red pepper




Put fish in 6"x10" baking dish. Combine remaining ingredients and pour over fish. Bake at 400 degrees for approximately 1/2 hour. Baste fish once or twice while baking.
