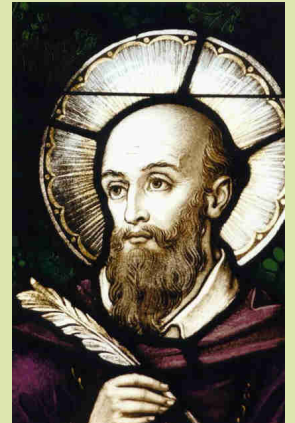

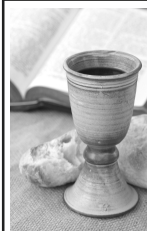

The Meaning of Human Sexuality

The tangible, earthly, corporeal world is more than inert matter or modeling clay for the human will. Creation is sacred. It has sacramental meaning. It reflects God's glory. That includes our bodies. Our sexuality has the power to procreate, and shares in the dignity of being created in the image of God. We need to live accordingly.

FALLS & HOW TO PREVENT THEM Part 2

Environmental risk factors such as certain medications (i.e. diuretics or tranquilizers), hazards that can cause tripping include slippery or uneven flooring, poor lighting, walking in socks or ill-fitting shoes. Personal risk factors such as having a history of falls, being age 65 or older, vision problems (such as changes in depth perception), weak muscles, trouble with balance or posture, urgent toileting needs, trouble remembering or understanding information, dizziness or difficulty walking are added factors in falls.

CAÍDAS y cómo prevenirlas

Los factores de riesgo ambientales, tales como ciertos medicamentos (diuréticos o tranquilizantes), peligros que pueden causar tropiezos incluyen suelos resbaladizos o irregulares, mala iluminación, caminando en calcetines o calzado inadecuado. Los factores de riesgo personales, como tener antecedentes de caídas, edad de 65 años o más, los problemas de visión (tales como los cambios en la percepción de profundidad), debilidad muscular, problemas con el balance o la postura, las necesidades de ir al baño urgentes, problemas para recordar o entender la información, mareos o dificultad para caminar son grandes factores que contribuyen riesgo a las caídas.

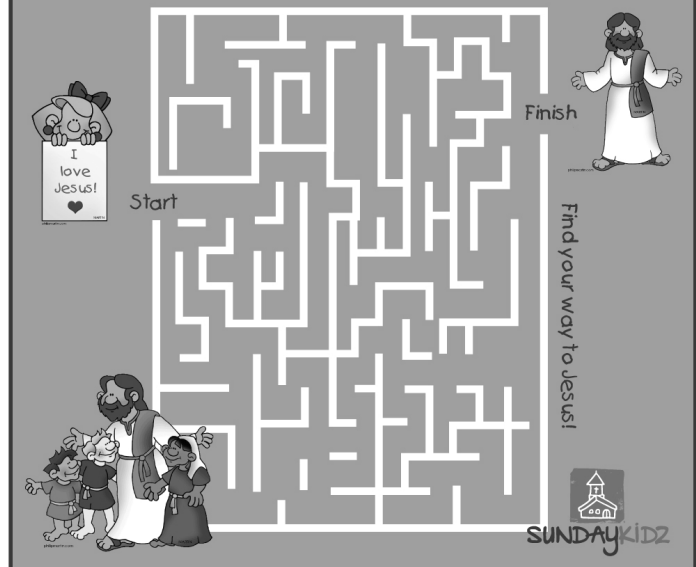

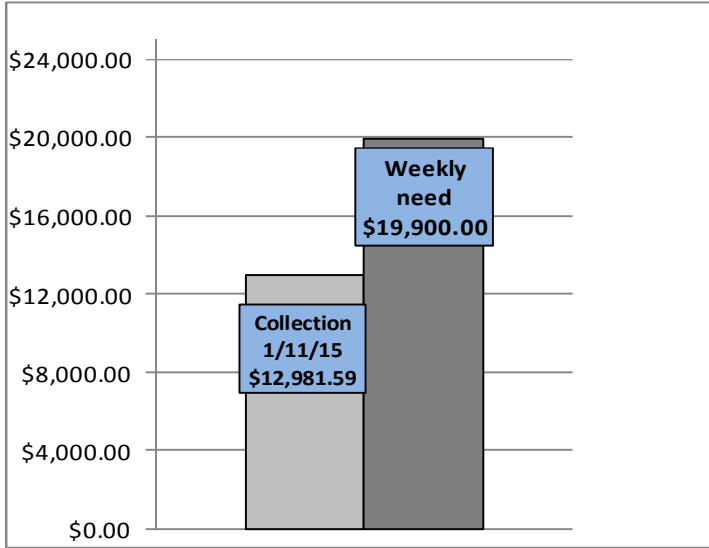

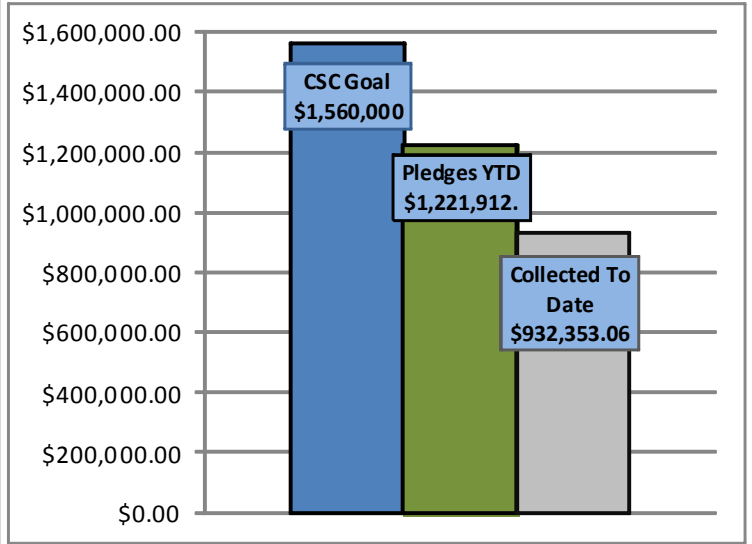
