

Sunday, March 1, 2015
Sharing in Christ's Passion and Death

Today's Readings: Genesis 22:1–2, 9a, 10–13, 15–18; Psalm 116:10, 15, 16, 17, 18–19 (116:9); Romans 8:31b–34; Mark 9:2–10. We see in the reading from Genesis that Abraham is directed to offer Isaac as a holocaust, but as he is about to slaughter his son, an angel stops him. God is pleased that Abraham trusts in the Lord enough that he would put to death his only son. God's love is such that he does not demand that Abraham make such a sacrifice.

In the Second Reading, we hear again of God's love and of trust in that love. Paul tells the Romans, "If God is for us, who is against us? He who did not withhold his own Son, but gave him up for all of us, will he not with him also give us everything else?" Paul relates the trustworthiness of God, who sacrificed his Son for us. Why would we not trust the one who gave so much for us? Are you acquainted with anyone who is more worthy of your trust?

The reaction of Apostles Peter, James, and John to the Transfiguration is similar to how we respond to great events in our lives. They have seen a vision of Elijah, who represents the prophets; of Moses, who represents the Law; and Jesus, who is the fulfillment of the Law and the prophets. In awe of this vision, they want to build tents and stay on the mountain. We, too, desire to stay with our mountaintop experiences. However, we need to move on and tend to our responsibilities in our work and family lives. But it is in those places that we can ponder the dying and the risings throughout our life.

Domingo, 1 de marzo del 2015

Participar de la pasión y muerte de Cristo

Lecturas del día: Génesis 22:1–2, 9a, 10–13, 15–18; Salmo 116:10, 15, 16–17, 18–19 (116:9); Romanos 8:31b–34; Marcos 9:2–10. En el Génesis escuchamos que Abraham obedece a Dios cuando se dispone a sacrificarle a Isaac en holocausto. Cuando está a punto de degollarlo, un ángel lo detiene. Dios se complace en la fe obediente de Abraham que no escatimó la vida de su hijo único. El amor de Dios es tal que no le exige semejante sacrificio a Abraham.

La segunda lectura habla del amor de Dios y de confiar en ese amor. Pablo dice a los Romanos: "Si Dios está de nuestra parte, ¿quién estará en contra? El que no reservó a su propio Hijo, sino que lo entregó por todos nosotros, ¿cómo no nos va a regalar todo lo demás con él?". Pablo subraya la confiabilidad de Dios, que sacrificó a su propio Hijo por nosotros. ¿Cómo no hemos de confiar en el que ha entregado tanto por nosotros? ¿Conoces a alguien que sea más digno de confianza?

La reacción de los apóstoles, Pedro, Santiago y Juan ante la transfiguración, es similar a la nuestra ante los grandes acontecimientos en nuestra vida. Ellos vieron a Elías, cifra de los Profetas, y a Moisés, de la Ley, y a Jesús, cumplimiento de la Ley y los Profetas. En medio de su asombro, quieren hacer tiendas para quedarse en la montaña. También nosotros deseamos quedarnos en nuestras experiencias cumbre. Sin embargo, tenemos que seguir adelante y atender las responsabilidades diarias, en el trabajo y en la vida familiar. Allí, justamente allí, es donde hay que experimentar el misterio de morir y resucitar, transfigurarnos.

Lenten Recipes / Recetas de Cuaresma

Broiled Tilapia with Lemon caper sauce

1-1/2 lbs. tilapia
2 tsp. extra virgil olive oil
1/2 cup Italian salad dressing
2 Tbsp. capers
1 tsp. parsley, chopped
2 Tbsp. lemon juice

Place tilapia on broiler pan and brush with olive oil. Broil fish until thoroughly cooked.

While fish is cooking, mix Italian dressing, lemon juice, capers and parsley together to make caper sauce.

Place fish on plates, drizzle each fish fillet with sauce and serve.
