



The Cross of Christ

Today's Readings: 2 Chronicles 36:14–16, 19–23; Psalm 137:1–2, 3, 4–5, 6 (6ab); Ephesians 2:4–10; John 3:14–21. Some might be surprised at the uplifting tone of the prayers and readings in today's Mass. We pray in the Entrance Antiphon, "Rejoice, Jerusalem," and in the Prayer over the Offerings, note that it is "with joy" that we place the offerings. It may not be widely understood that Lent has a joyful aspect. Today, on Laetare Sunday, when rose-colored vestments may be worn, we look past the seriousness of Lent and acknowledge our joy in Christ.

The readings provide the reason for our rejoicing. In the First Reading, we see that the Lord has compassion on his people, and in the Second Reading, that God is "rich in mercy." St. Paul's words to the Ephesians underscore that all we have is a gift from God. "By grace you have been saved," he says. Our grace comes to us entirely without our merit. Just as the Lord sent messengers to his people while they were unfaithful, he provides us with grace even while we are in sin. That grace has made us alive in Christ.

In John's account of the Gospel, we are told why God is compassionate and merciful to us. It is because he loves us. He "so loved the world that he gave his only Son" so that all who believe may have eternal life. With this knowledge, how could we live anything but joyful lives? How might you acknowledge your joy in Christ?

La cruz de Cristo

Lecturas del día: 2 Crónicas 36:14–16, 19–23; Salmo 37:1–2, 3, 4–5, 6 (6ab); Efesios 2:4–10; Juan 3:14–21. Alguien puede sorprenderse del tono exaltado de las plegarias y lecturas de la misa de hoy. La Antífona de entrada entona: "Regocijáte Jerusalén", y la Oración sobre las ofrendas las presenta "con alegría". Esta fecha la Cuaresma tiene un aspecto alegre. Es Domingo de Laetare; se pueden usar ornamentos color rosa, y aunque tomamos con seriedad la Cuaresma reconocemos nuestra alegría en Cristo.

Las lecturas dan la razón para alegrarnos. En la primera, vemos que el Señor tiene compasión de su pueblo; en la segunda, que Dios es "rico en misericordia". San Pablo subraya esto a los efesios diciendo que cuanto tenemos es don de Dios. "Por gracia han sido salvados", apunta. Nuestra gracia no deriva de mérito nuestro. Así como el Señor envía mensajeros a su pueblo infiel, ahora nos provee con su gracia, aun cuando estemos en pecado. Su gracia nos hace vivir en Cristo.

En el relato del evangelio de san Juan, se nos dice porqué Dios es compasivo y misericordioso con nosotros: nos ama. "Tanto amó al mundo que le dio a su único Hijo, para que todo el que cree tenga vida eterna". Sabiendo esto, ¡cómo no vamos a estar alegres! ¡Pongamos en Cristo nuestra alegría!




BLOOD DRIVE:

Lenten Recipes / Recetas de Cuaresma

Creamy Shrimp & Pasta

1/4 lb linguini, uncooked
1 cup medium shrimp, peeled, deveined, tails off.
2 chopped tomatoes
1/2 cup cream cheese (can use reduced-fat)
1/2 cup washed fresh baby spinach leaves

Cook pasta as directed, drain. While pasta cooks heat a large skillet on medium-high heat. Add shrimp, tomatoes and cream cheese. Cook and stir 3-4 minutes or until well blended. Place pasta in large bowl, add spinach and toss lightly. Stir in shrimp mixture and serve with crusty bread. Serves 2

Pasta con Camarones Cremosos

1/4 de pasta de linguini, sin cocinar
1 taza de camarones tamaño mediano, sin cola , pelados y desvainados
2 jitomates picados
1/2 taza de queso filadelfia (se puede usar el que tiene poca grasa)
1/2 taza de hojas de espinaca pequeña bien lavada

Cocine la pasta, escurre el agua. Mientras se cocina la pasta, caliente una cazuela grande a flama media. Añádale los camarones, los jitomates y el queso filadelfia. Cocínelos de 3 a 4 minutos mientras los mezcla bien. Ponga la pasta en un tazón grande, añádale la espinaca y mézclela un poco. Incorpore la mezcla de camarones y sirva con pan duro. Es suficiente para 2 platos.




