Highlights of FY 2017 Financial Report

- Excluding activity related to the capital campaign, our fiscal 2017 receipts exceeded our
 expenditures by \$61,188 (4.7% of expenditures). Since our church building is now about 20 years
 old, we need such surpluses to allow us to set aside reserves for future maintenance and
 updating projects.
- Overall, our fiscal 2017 offertory collections were almost 7% higher than in fiscal 2016! The offertory is our largest and most regular source of income.
- Our giving through the offertory collection varies considerably from one month to the next, making budgeting difficult.
 - While almost 950 households are mailed envelopes, only 325 are returned in the offertory.
 - One way to ensure consistent giving is to donate electronically; 187 households are already doing this. It's easy and safe. Please click on "give online" from stfrancisholland.org. Our parish will benefit if we increase these numbers.
- Generous gifts to our capital campaign (*Growing our Faith*) enabled us to accomplish the
 following in fiscal 2017: install new door-access controls, directional signage, and carpeting;
 provide scholarship and tuition support to Corpus Christi School; and help Corpus Christi
 undertake a major masonry project.
- Catholic Services Appeal 2016 (completed in March 2017) was a big success! We met our diocesan assessment, and also raised all the funded needs to repair our bell tower.
